How to Create a Graphic Map

- 1. Using the Graphic Map interactive, you can record 15 events.
- 2. After selecting the events to be represented, arrange them in chronological order (which happened first, next, last).
- 3. Open the Graphic Map Interactive, type in your name and the title for your graphic map.
- 4. On the next screen, you will be given a list of items. Choose **Other** and type in "Event".
- 5. The following screen asks for your rating system. Select **Positive/Negative**.
- 6. The next screen asks you to enter your information.
 - a. EVENT—serves as a label
 - b. TOPIC—a word or phrase that tells what the item is
 - c. **DESCRIPTION**—a longer explanation of the topic
- 7. The final step is to choose a picture. You have two options:
 - a. Selecting from a menu of clip art pictures
 - b. In the Miscellaneous Category, you can choose a border. When the graphic map prints out, you can draw your own picture.
- 8. When you are finished entering events, you will print your Graphic Map.
