Choose a topic and reading materials of **personal interest** to you in order to create a written project for yourself, and, hopefully, others. *Time-- Find 5 min; Read and Notes 60 min; Product 10 min; Practice 10 min; Share 10+ min*

1 Read about your topic during **MOTT**.

- Read on your topic.
- Write questions you want answered.
- Focus on understanding.
- Take notes of interest to your own questions about the topic.
- Think about your possible product/project.

Peruse information.

2 Represent your learning and thoughts in your notebook.

Free response suggestions:

Statements: I learned, I wonder, I agree, I disagree, This is like, etc.

Representations: pictures, pictographs, webs, lists, relationships, graphic organizers, etc.

Structured Response suggestions:

Reflection questions: How would you use this information?

How important is the information to you? Why?

What do you find most interesting about the information? Why?

What are some questions you have about what you have read?

How is what you read different from what you thought you knew?

Actions : Construct a graphic organizer representing something you found interesting.

Construct a picture of something you just read about.

Construct a pictograph of something important to your topic.

Process information.

3 Interact with others to share your information.

Share information: Display a summary or clarification of your **MOTT** interests. Obtain a signature from the person with whom you shared.

Broster (8 1/2 by 11 in. brief poster)with

Produce information.
